



## Traveling West on I-40 to UT Medical Center

### SmartFIX40 Project—Travel Routes During the I-40 Closure

Beginning May 1, 2008, a short section of I-40 between James White Parkway (exit 388A) and Hall of Fame Drive (exit 389) will be closed to traffic for reconstruction. We suggest using these alternate travel routes in getting to the Medical Center.

#### Option 1

I-40 West to I-640 West to I-275 South to I-40 West to Alcoa Hwy 129 South (exit 386B) to the Medical Center. 13.4 Miles from the I-640 West and I-40 West split.

#### Option 2

I-40 West to Hall of Fame Drive (exit 389) turning right onto to Summit Hill and turning left onto S. Central Street to Neyland Drive turning right onto Kingston Pike to Hwy 129 South to the Medical Center. 9.8 Miles and 15 Traffic Lights from the I-40 and I-640 split.

To ensure that you arrive for your appointment on time, please allow yourself extra time by leaving 30 minutes earlier than normal. Also stay tuned to your local media outlets for updates on traffic conditions for the Knoxville area.
