As one of only five designated centers in Tennessee, the Regional Perinatal Program provides the Eastern region with specialized obstetrical care and neonatal services. Funding is provided by the state to assure that high-risk perinatal services and clinical education are in place statewide.

What type of training is provided?

Helping providers prepare for complex obstetric and neonatal conditions is an important goal of the Regional Perinatal Program. FREE training is provided for those in pre-hospital, clinical and hospital settings, including ancillary providers. Professional education classes and realistic emergency drills are conducted throughout the region using a range of simulation equipment, following evidence-based guidelines. With the goal of improving maternal and neonatal outcomes, our nurse clinical educators and staff take pride in the important training provided across the region.
